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Overview

LandTrack Systems offers a suite of tools built for mining industry professionals to help acquire, protect, manage, report, and track mineral title compliance, tenure-related agreements, and environmental conditions. **LandTracker** is a multi-jurisdictional asset and compliance management system that leverages key government databases, securing company's tenure with exclusive technology and audited data. This customisable system integrates seamlessly with your organisation's compliance processes, safeguarding your holdings and streamlining management. **Expenditure Watch** fills the gaps between the accounting system, tenement administration and exploration planning. Expenditure Watch is designed specifically to address difficulties with traditional tenement expenditure reporting. **GeoSearch** is a land monitoring tool built to acquire new ground and protect your tenure with automated alerts about land use changes in your specified area of interest. **Tenement Safety Net** sends concise, timely reports detailing critical compliance actions across your land assets.

LandTracker Vanilla Slice Release Notes (24 September 2026)

New Features

- Views can be organised with three-level grouping, combining modules, categories and individual views. System views are categorised automatically and custom views can be assigned to categories. Three-level grouping is enabled by default. To restore the original two-level view structure, administrators can add **EnableThreeLevelViewGrouping="false"** to **Application Settings**.
- Asset Templates support calculated columns defined with Word endnotes. Calculated values can use fields, arithmetic, logical expressions, date, string and numeric functions. Expressions are evaluated when the data grid loads, and users must save before closing the data grid to retain recalculated values and other data changes.
- Completed actions can trigger dependent on-demand actions automatically. Action definitions can specify the triggered action and a deadline offset, while duplicate prevention and source-action links provide reliable scheduling and traceability.

Enhancements

- Action Definition preconditions support complex expressions that combine multiple fields, calculations, comparison and logical operators, date, string and numeric functions and advanced function **IN**. Existing simple preconditions remain supported.
- Action Definitions support the **Is Not Member Of** condition, allowing actions to be excluded for assets belonging to specified groups.
- The data-grid filter language supports **NOT LIKE**. The **<>** operator performs wildcard-based negative matching, allowing users to filter out values that contain specified text.
- LandTracker has a refreshed user interface with an updated colour palette and icon set.



- Manual row creation is disabled for Templates, Action Definitions and Recurring Actions. These definitions must be created through the applicable import workflow, helping prevent incomplete definitions and related errors.
- Northern Territory Asset Templates and Action Definitions have been updated to reflect amendments to the Mining Act.
- The Western Australia (WA) graticular-block approximation used by **Approximate Area in Hectares** has been updated from 280 hectares to 310 hectares. The calculation factors can be adjusted by editing the AreaConversion in Application Settings.
- LandTracker displays an advance warning at application startup when the installed version expires within 14 days. The warning shows the expiry date and remaining days and provides guidance for obtaining the latest version.
- Added support for MTO specialIndicator for distinguishing Western Australia (WA) Prospecting Licences from Special Prospecting Licences.

Defect Fixes

- Editor roles could not import tenements in some databases because the import process could select an incorrect template. Template selection has been corrected so eligible editors can import tenements reliably.
- Custom views created from Proceeding Actions disappeared from **View Agreement Actions** after the screen was reopened. Proceeding view types are now included when Agreement action views are loaded.
- Deleting all instances of an Action Definition and then deleting the definition did not record the deleting user in the Activity Log. The username is now captured with this deletion event.
- Opening **Manage Views** after all available columns had been enabled could cause the window to fail. Temporary columns are excluded from the view-column menus and missing linked columns are handled safely.
- Action date calculations could be incorrect for users whose regional settings used the MM/DD/YYYY format. Australian date parsing is now applied consistently to the affected calculations.
- **Freshdesk case: 279802 Next Report Date in Manage Alerts** could display the first report date instead of the next scheduled date after a schedule change. The displayed date now reflects the next scheduled report.
- Alerts could continue to be generated after the configured recurrence end date. Recurrence processing now stops when the end date is reached.



- For South Australia (SA), the **Combined Reporting Group (SA)** field on tenements could be saved as free text instead of linking to the matching Combined Reporting Group record. The field now links correctly to the existing group.
- **Freshdesk case: 265931** WA tenement **M57/160A** could not be found or imported because the data-service parser removed the **A** suffix from the TenID. The parser now preserves the suffix so the tenement can be located and imported.
- Updating and auditing linked data could create duplicate Related Agreement, Related Tenement or Related Environment links. Link processing now prevents duplicate relationships.



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
